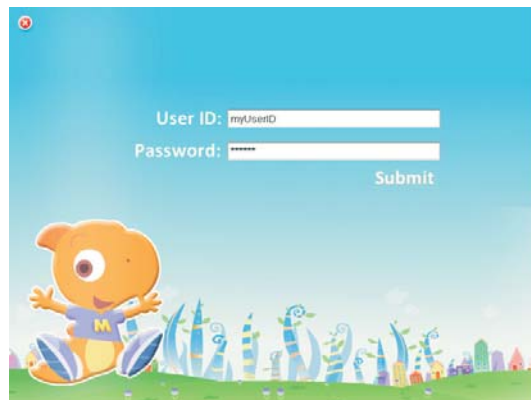
- Windows XP / Vista operating system

- Hard disk with 2.5 GB of free space available

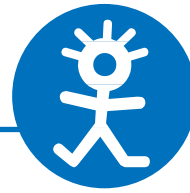
READ FIRST BEFORE YOU INSTALL

- Before you install the program, you must log-in as the 'administrator' (not as a 'guest') to the computer if you have multiple user accounts for the computer.
- If your PC does not have Apple QuickTime Player, please install this program first.
- Your PC needs to have an always-on Internet connection.

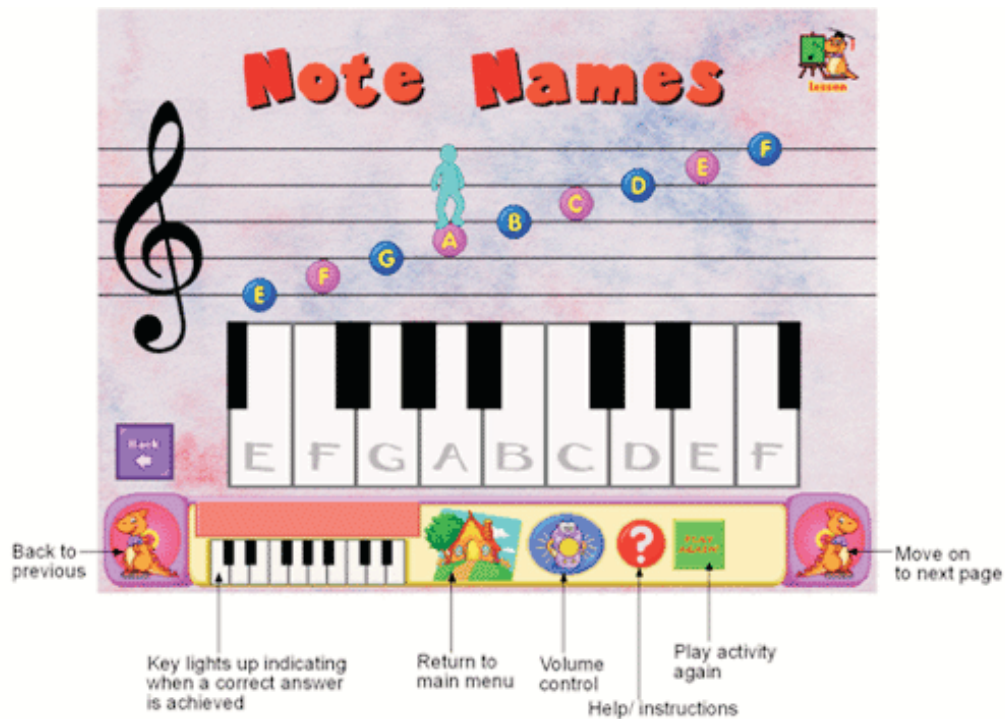

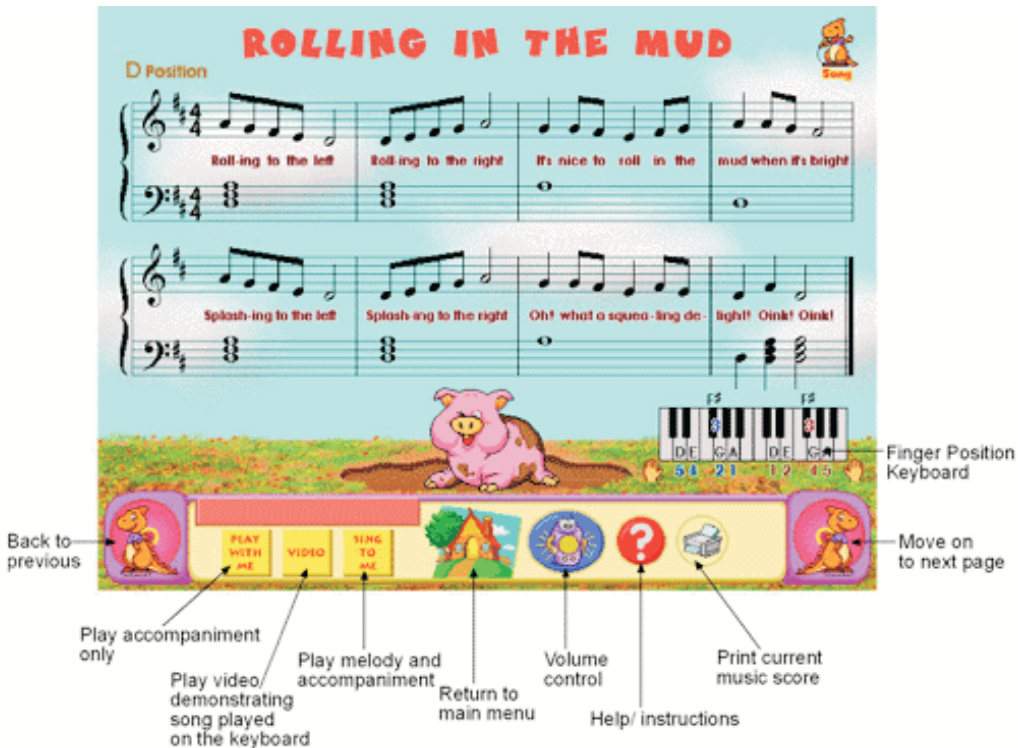

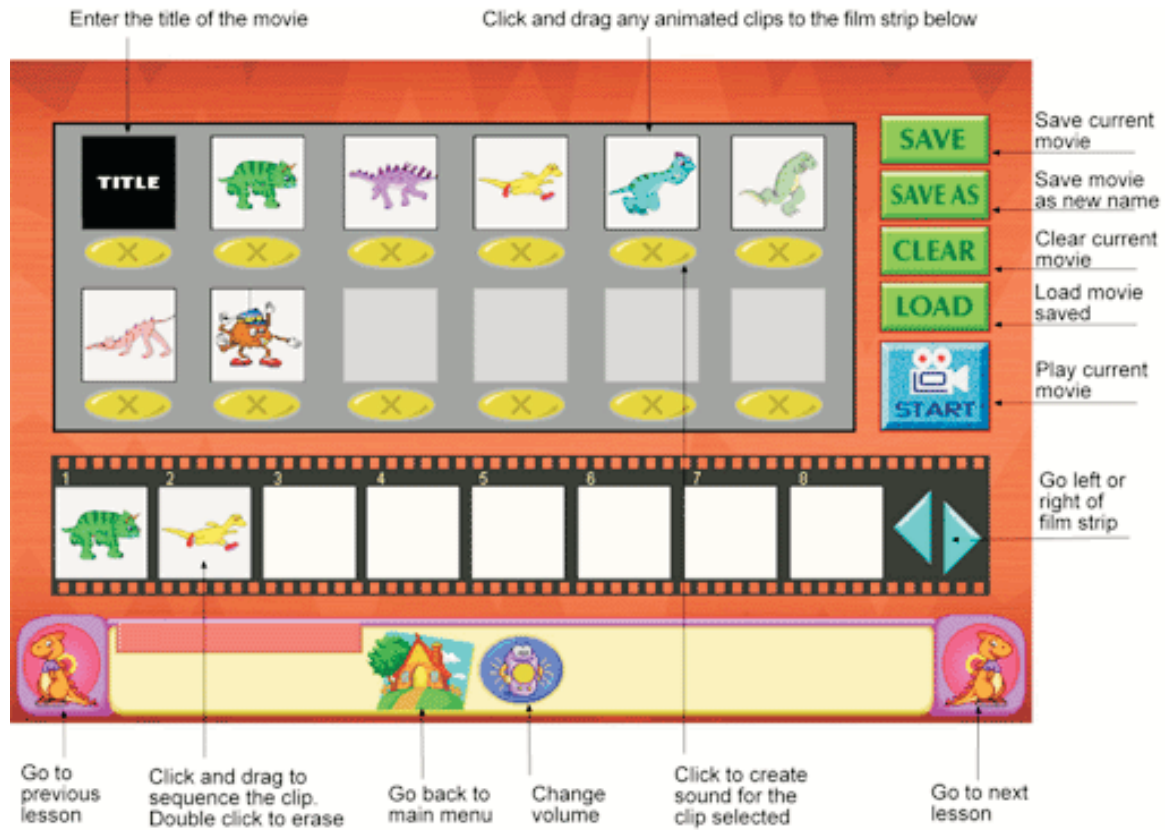


Guide to "Song" screen

Guide to "Music Composition" screen
